SOUNDSYSTEM

A professional full range sound system capable of providing adequate sound for everyone in the audience and every musician on stage.

FOH: Meyersound / D&B / EAW, including sub lows Consoles: Midas / Yamaha / Soundcraft (or equivalent)

2 X Graphic EQ 31-bands, system EQ

FX: 1 reverb and 1 delay-unit

MONITOR SYSTEM

4 discreet monitor mixes to be completely independent of the house system

5 X 12" or 15" equal monitor wedges: Meyersound / D&B or equivalent

4 X Graphic EQ 31-bands on monitor inserts

FX: 1X reverb

LIGHTS

a professional light system with theatre lights on dimmers to create separate front, top and back-light for the band

All equipment should be setup and checked, ready to operate prior to the start of the soundcheck with the band.

TEMPERATURE - CLIMATE

Temperature of the hall during sound check, rehearsal, brakes, concert has to be at minimum 21 Celsius degrees, maximum 24 Celsius degrees.

BACK-LINE

instruments, accessories or other needs, which the venue should provide.

Percussion: - 1 bass drum + pedal

- 1 floor tom (with coated skin, white skin)

- 4 Strong Cymbal stands

- 1 snare drum stand

1 high-hat pedal1 adjustable drum chair

- 1 rubber mat or rugged carpet 1,5 x 2 square meters

Guitar: - Fender Reverb Deluxe Amplifier (or simular)

- Backline Power 220 V

- Guitar Stand

- 2 spare 1/4 " jack-jack cables

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Cello: - Bass Amplifier (Markbass, Ampeg)

Backline Power 220 V, 4 sockets2 spare 1/4 " jack-jack cables

- armless chair

Kora: - armless chair, Backline Power 220 V

- Guitar Amplifier for the Kora (AER alpha, Fender Deluxe)

- 2 spare 1/4 " jack-jack cables

Stage plan -

From perspective of audience member, Position from left to right in a semi circle CELLO (left front)

PERCUSSION (centre back)

MBIRA/KORA + VOX (right front)

GUITAR + VOX (centre front)

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All cables, microphones, monitors and DI boxes arranged on stage should be ready and operating at the start of the sound check
